



## FERTILIZER AND WEED CONTROL SERVICE DESCRIPTION AND SPECIFICATIONS

### Warm-Season Lawns (Bermuda/Zoysia) 8-Step Program

Round 1 & 2 WINTER Jan/Feb	Pre-emergent weed control and fertilizer. Spot treatment of existing weeds. May be combined based on timing and weather conditions.
Round 3 SPRING March/April	Balanced fertilizer with weed control applied. Spot treatment of existing weeds.
Round 4 SUMMER May/June	Balanced fertilizer applied. Spot treatment of existing weeds.
Round 5 SUMMER July/August	Balanced fertilizer applied. Spot treatment of existing weeds.
Round 6 & 7 FALL September/ October	Pre-emergent weed control and fertilizer. Spot treatment of existing weeds. May be combined based on timing and weather conditions.
Round 8 FALL November/ December	Lime is applied (as required) to adjust the soil pH and prepare your lawn for the next growing season. Spot treatment of existing weeds.

Note: Additional services may be required to control lawn diseases or other issues, based on visual inspection during each service visit. We will recommend additional services as needed.

**Cool-Season Lawns (Fescue) 6-Step Program**

Round 1 WINTER Jan/Feb	Pre-emergent weed control and fertilizer. Spot treatment of existing weeds.
Round 2 SPRING March/April	Balanced fertilizer with weed control applied. Spot treatment of existing weeds.
Round 3 SUMMER May/June	Balanced fertilizer with iron applied. Spot treatment of existing weeds.
Round 4 SUMMER July/August	Spot treatment of existing weeds. (Fungicide applied at additional cost)
Round 5 FALL September/ October	Balanced fertilizer with weed control applied. Spot treatment of existing weeds. (Overseed Fescue at additional cost.)
Round 6 FALL November/ December	Balanced fertilizer with weed control applied. Spot treatment of existing weeds.

Note: Additional services may be required to control lawn diseases or other issues, based on visual inspection during each service visit. We will recommend additional services as needed.

## **Additional Services**

Overseeding	Thickens your fescue lawn.
Fire Ant Control	Control fire ants for 12 months by treating entire lawn, OR, treat mounds individually per visit.
Grub Control	Control grubs in your lawn.
Flea and Tick Control	Control fleas and ticks for up to 30 days per treatment.
Disease Control	Control brown spot, dollar spot, and other turf diseases.

## **Program/Service Notes**

1. "Make it Right" Guarantee
  - a. If you ever have any problems/issues with our service, just call or email and we will "make it right".
2. Licensing
  - a. Our company is a licensed Pesticide Contractor and all of our individual lawn care technicians are licensed Pesticide Applicators.
  - b. This is required in GA for any company/person that applies lawn chemicals on a "for hire" basis
3. Soil Testing
  - a. We suggest testing the soil in your lawn every 2 years (per UGA guidelines) in order to ensure proper nutrient levels and overall soil health.
4. Granular Product Program
  - a. Our program is based on the use of granular products (vs liquid products)
  - b. Advantages of a granular program:
    - i. Feeds grass plants the natural way, through the root system.
    - ii. Some granular products are specially coated to provide a time release effect.
    - iii. Time release properties of the granular pellets provides longer term benefits to the health of the grass plant and have a low burn potential.
    - iv. Slow release provides for long benefits and fewer applications.
5. Integrated Pest Management
  - a. Our company practices and recommends an "Integrated Pest Management" approach to lawn care, which includes monitoring, prevention, and control.
